GIN

Measure 50ml

Whitley Neill Original 8.95

Whitley Neill Gin is slightly softer and much smoother than traditional gins, with rich notes of juniper and citrus, pot pourri and exotic spices.

Whitley Neill Quince 9.75

With aromas of fresh stone fruits, hints of juniper and citrus zest. The distinctive flavour of quince dominates the palate, with a long, fruity finish of orange blossom and zesty grapefruit.

Whitley Neill Rhubarb & Ginger 9.75

Inspired by the glory of English country gardens, the essence of rhubarb adds a tart crisp edge to the smooth base, whilst the ginger extract warms the palate for a full bodied finish.

City of London Distillery The Square Mile 9.95

Square Mile Gin is full of classic flavours of juniper berries, coriander, orris root, angelica, liquorice, fresh orange, lemon and other botanicals.

GIN

Measure 50ml

City of London Distillery Murcian Orange 9.95

Distilled in the heart of the Square Mile and inspired by the citrus fruits that would have descended down the River Thames from distant lands as the British Empire flourished.

No. 3 London Dry 10.95

ISC four times winner of 'World Gin of the Year' and 'Best Spirit in the World'. No. 3 London Dry is distilled in copper pot stills, counts cardamom seeds and grapefruit peel among its botanicals, and has been bottled at an invigorating 46%.

Marylebone Cask Aged 14.75

This light coloured gin has sweet floral and citrus notes on the nose. There is rich juniper, hints of spice, citrus, and vanilla on the palate with lingering notes of cinnamon and black pepper to finish.

Marylebone London Dry 14.75

The unique, balanced flavour and aroma of Marylebone Gin derives from their use of the purest grain spirit and careful selection of the finest botanicals from around the globe.

VODKA

Measure 50ml

Belvedere Pure 9.95

Belvedere is unique thanks to its locally sourced ingredients: Dankowskie gold rye and pristine artesian water from Belvedere's own wells. The rye creates character and the water brings smoothness.

Broken Clock 13.95

Described as a 'Lingering Vodka' made in a copper pot still and infused with slow ripened apples from the garden at Shandy Hall in Coxwold, Yorkshire, along with botanicals from old Georgian gardens. The result is a particularly smooth herbaceous vodka with notes of apple and cinnamon crumble and freshly-mown grass.

Puffing Billy Vodka 11.30

A unique vodka here from The Borders Distillery, Puffing Billy is made with a base of malted barley, which is pot-distilled and then redistilled using a specially-commissioned Carterhead still named Puffing Billy that steams the spirit vapours through charcoal inside the still itself.

COGNAC

Measure 50ml

Hennessy VS 11.30

Benchmark VS from one of Cognac's 'Big Four' producers. Popular the world over for its elegant style and consistent high quality.

Hennessy XO 35

The original 'extra-old' cognac, first bottled in 1870 by Maurice Hennessy for family and friends. Darker and complex with appealing leather and tobacco notes and a touch of spice – a great cigar cognac.

Hennessy 1982 45

A very special Cognac found only at Boisdale.

Delamain Vintage 1982 Grande Champagne 34.75

This vintage Delamain showcases a real fruitiness with rich caramel notes. 25 years old, landed in 1984, and bottled by Justerini & Brooks in 2007

Hine 1986 32.50

Providing another good reason to adore Hine vintage Cognac, this is extremely delicate and complex. 20 years old, landed in 1988, and bottled by Justerini & Brooks in 2006.

COGNAC

Louis XIII

Each decanter is the life achievement of generations of cellar masters. Since its origins in 1874, each generation of cellar master selects the oldest and most precious eaux-de-vie for Louis XIII. Today, Cellar Master Baptiste Loiseau is setting aside our nest eaux-de-vie, as a legacy to his successors for the coming century. Louis XIII is a fragrance – the fragrance of time.

WHISKY

Measure 50ml

Crabbies Yardhead 9.50

Relatively young single malt whisky with aromas and flavour of biscuit, vanilla, citrus, sweet apple, caramel and toffee apple. Pairs well with ginger beer or cola.

Lower East Side 11.35

Lower East Side is a light and fruity blended malt Scotch whisky from The Borders Distillery Company – the blend was composed from a range of single malts sourced from all across Scotland.

Ardbeg 10 13.65

For peat lovers, Ardbeg 10-year-old is probably the highest-quality 'entry-level' single malt on the market, and the distillery many Islay connoisseurs would choose as their favourite. A whirlwind of peat and complex malty flavours.

Glenmorangie 10 12.50

Sets a high standard for Highland whisky, medium bodied and gently warming with spicy notes.

Crabbies 12 12.50

Intensively malty single malt, fresh with light notes of green grass and a touch of juicy citrus. It has a rich full flavour with a fabulous bitter sweet balance, followed by a touch of sweet honey and notes of grilled orange and green tea.

WHISKY

Measure 50ml

The Glenrothes 12 13.95

A Glenrothes 12-year-old in classic style: fruity and sweet. Aged solely in sherry-seasoned casks, this Speyside whisky has notes of vanilla, melon, banana and cinnamon.

Glenmorangie 12 Nectar D'Or 16.50

This is a sauternes finished single malt, quite full with dessert wine notes, cereal notes and barley. A touch of malty spice and berry fruits with good oaky tannins develops.

Aberfeldy 12 14.90

The classic Aberfeldy 12-year-old single malt Scotch whisky is distilled in the Highlands and delivers a rich, malty and honeyed flavour profile

Dewars 12 13.50

The classic 12-year-old blend from Dewars and the successor to Dewar's "Double Aged" 12-year-old – so named in reference to the additional six month marriage the whisky enjoys in oak after the initial maturation and blending.

Aultmore 12 16

Part of Dewar's The Last Great Malts range launched in 2014, this 12-year-old Aultmore is the first release from the distillery for a few years and is elegant, light and fruity.

WHISKY

Measure 50ml

Royal Brackla 12 16.90

A 2015 release as part of the Last Great Malts series, Royal Brackla 12-year-old is finished in first-fill Oloroso sherry casks and is light and spicy with notes of vanilla and black pepper.

Craigellachie 13 15.80

Bonfire night in a glass – aromas of oozing toasted marshmallows, roasted pineapple and baked apples studded with cloves, with the tang of cordite lingering in the background.

Aberfeldy 16 20.20

Aberfeldy 16-year-old was released in 2015 as part of The Last Great Malts series. Matured in a combination of bourbon and sherry casks, this has lovely balance between sweetness and spiciness.

Royal Brackla 16 25.70

Royal Brackla was the first distillery to be allowed to use the 'Royal' title, and 2015 saw it get its own range of single malts. Part of the Last Great Malts series, the 16-year-old is finished in first-fill oloroso sherry casks and is sweet and spicy, with a hint of smoke in the mix, too.

Craigellachie 17 30.20

A range of Craigellachie single malts was released for the first time in 2014. The distillery is known for its meaty character, and the 17-year-old is sweet and slightly smoky, with tropical fruit notes.

WHISKY

Measure 50ml

The Glenrothes 18 31.10

Matured in sherry casks, the majority of which were first-fill, this is a sweet and spicy whisky with notes of vanilla, fresh ginger and pear.

The Glenrothes 25 75

The pinnacle of The Glenrothes new range is this decadent 25-year-old, which was awarded the Chairman's Trophy at the 2018 Ultimate Spirits Challenge. Aged in mostly first-fill sherry-seasoned casks, it has notes of tropical fruits, coriander seed and salted caramel.

The Glenrothes Whisky Makers Cut 18.50

A rich non-age-statement whisky matured entirely in first-fill sherry casks, with notes of orange, vanilla, nutmeg and oak. It is part of The Soleo Collection: a range of five whiskies from Glenrothes, ranging from 10 to 25 years old, which pay homage to the grapes from which some sherries, such as Pedro Ximénez, are made.

RUM

Measure 50ml

Bacardi Superior Carta Blanca 7.20

The best-selling spirit brand worldwide, enjoyed in more than 170 countries. Bacardi Carta Blanca was created in 1862 and is still, remarkably, a family-controlled brand.

Bacardi Anejo Cuatro 4yr 8.70

A four-year-old golden rum that's inspired by Bacardi founder Don Facundo's original recipe. Anejo Cuatro is a vibrant spirit with notes of honey, vanilla and oak spices, as well as a smooth palate that's rounded out by the inclusion of some five and six-year-old rums.

Santa Teresa 1796 16.30

Honeyed single estate rum from Venezuela with elements of bitter chocolate, nuts and buttery biscuits. Unusually for a rum it is made through the solera process: casks of different aged rums are stacked vertically with the oldest (aged around 35 years) at the bottom, and as the distiller draws rum from one cask they top it up with younger liquid from the blend.

TEQUILA

Measure 50ml

Codigo 1530 Rosa 14.25

The liquid spends a month resting in barrels that previously held Napa Cabernet wine.

Codigo 1530 Blanco 14.75

Made with agave which has grown for over seven years before being distilled. Top quality stuff.

Codigo 1530 Reposado 15.65

Only agave over seven years old is distilled and matured for six months in Napa Cabernet barrels.

Ambhar Tequila Reposado 15

An ultra-premium tequila that is perfect for tequila connoisseurs who want a remarkable smoothness. It is rested in premium whiskey oak barrels for 364 days, giving it its pale golden hue. The aging process is timed perfectly to impart a perfect balance of fresh agave, vanilla and salted caramel.

Ambhar Tequila Anejo 16.50

A delicately aged tequila, resting in premium whiskey oak barrels for over two years. The extended amount of aging produces its dark amber colour and caramel-like notes. This spirit inherits unique flavours of soft and silky mixtures of vanilla and candied citrus peel. Its fuller body makes it a perfect ultra-premium tequila for sipping.
