

Our semi-permanent lip blush tattoo is a semi-transparent technique of tattooing. The healed result resembles a tinted lipstick or lip gloss. Technique lasts 1-3 years on average.

Precautions for Lips

**VERY IMPORTANT** If you have ever had a cold sore you need to get your doctor to prescribe you an antiviral.

(Because tattooing causes trauma to the lip you will most likely get a really bad outbreak if you have the virus anywhere in your body.)

This reaction can be quite severe if the proper precautions are not taken! I would not risk not getting a prescription if you even suspect you have ever had a cold sore in the past.

You just need to take it the day of the procedure and for 3 days after... keeping in mind you will come back one more time for a touch-up in 8 weeks and will be required to take the medicine one more time.

If you have NOT had a cold sore outbreak please take L-Lysine leading up to your appointment ( it is an amino acid that helps boost immunity and Aide in healing) of course always consult a healthcare professional prior to taking any medicine)

This product is available at many health, supplement stores, roots and London Drugs.

According to study our pain threshold is lower four days prior and after our period. Please take note of this when you are booking your appointment.

**APPOINTMENT PREP:**

If needed get a prescription for Valtrex or start taking L-Lysine (if required) 10days- 2 week prior to apt, continue to take a few weeks after as well

Lightly exfoliate lips a few days before service with a light sugar scrub

If you have a certain color in mind please bring photos or your own lipstick we can use as a guide when choosing a colour

**Contraindications for Lip Tattoo:**

We do not recommend carrying out the procedure in the presence of skin diseases eg. active herpes outbreak, as well as people suffering from a tendency to form keloids, bleeding disorders, uncontrolled diabetes.

If you have naturally dark pigmented lips ( brown in colour as a whole or blotches of brown) you may need to get your lips neutralized, we also offer LIP NEUTRALIZATION.
